Frontier House:

- Was established in 1990, following the Clubhouse Model of Psychosocial Rehabilitation, first established in NYC's Fountain House nearly 70 years ago.
- Operates on proven, international Clubhouse Standards developed over decades to help people reach their full potential.
- Is open to anyone 18 and older with a history of mental illness. Potential members can be referred from any mental health provider.
- Offers vocational programs such as transitional, supported, and independent employment. Over 65% of active Frontier House members are employed.

Clubhouses:

- **Are community-based membership organizations** designed to support people living with mental illness. Members gain free access to opportunities to rejoin the worlds of friendship, family, employment, and education; and the services and support to continue their recovery.
- **Run on the "Work-Ordered Day,"** an eight-hour period, typically Monday-Friday, which parallels the typical business hours of the working community. Members and staff work side by side to perform work important to their community. There are no clinical therapies or treatment programs involved. Members volunteer to participate as they feel ready.
- **Maximize dollars and wellness.** One year of holistic recovery services delivered via Clubhouse costs the same as a two-week psychiatric hospital stay.
- **Reduce incarcerations and hospitalizations.** Criminal justice system and hospital involvement is substantially diminished during and after clubhouse membership.

Membership benefits include:

- Vocational rehabilitation and supported education and volunteer services.
- Meaningful relationships and a community of peer support.
- Recovery and wellness programming.
- Community support services, including housing assistance and referrals.
- Skill development.
- Access to leisure activities leading to positive social interactions and relationships.
- Involvement in local, state, national, and international organizations.
